





 - *Historical and Regulatory Site Overview*




- *Developed Work Plan for FY 2009 activities*

Project Status Updates

- **X-701B Oxidant Treatment Project**
 - *Phase II oxidant injections were completed at 120 Gallia locations on October 29, 2008*
- **X-740 Groundwater Plume Area**
 - *Post Phase III groundwater samples were completed on October 8, 2008*
- **7-Unit Groundwater Plume Investigation**
 - *An investigation work plan was submitted to DOE on October 30, 2008 and is currently in review*






Project Status Updates

- **X-344C Deferred Unit Investigation**

An Investigation Work Plan was submitted to DOE on October 20, 2008 and is currently in review




- **X-770 Concrete Pad Removal / Investigation**
 - *Field investigation work began on September 24, 2008 to sample soils beneath the concrete pad remaining from the X-770 building demolition.*
 - *Sampling activities were completed October 2, 2008.*






New Starts


- **Cleanout of DMSAs 11&12 in X-326 Building**
 - *November 2008: Begin Phase I disposition*
- **X-746 Shipping and Receiving Building Removal Project**
 - *DOE provided Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) to Ohio EPA on October 29, 2008, for review and comments and to US EPA for information*






New Starts

- **Excess Materials Disposition**
 - *DOE initiating project to dispose 17 piles of excess materials (approx. 257,000 cu. ft.) located throughout PORTS site*
 - *DOE awarded contract modification to LPP for work scope on October 30, 2008*
 - *Contractor to submit list of materials for reuse or recycling*
 - *Project completion by September 15, 2009*






New Starts

- **X-345 Building Cleanout**

- *Project being initiated to dismantle and dispose of High Activity Sampling and Analysis (HASA) Lab and supporting equipment, and High Assay Isotopic Standards Preparation (HAISP) Lab from inside X-345 Building*
- *DOE awarded contract modification to LPP for work scope on October 30, 2008*
- *Waste shipments to start by March 2009*
- *Completion by September 15, 2009*

The changing mission of the Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant . . .




Shutdown of the gaseous diffusion uranium enrichment process and demolition of structures no longer needed such as the X-616 Liquid Effluent Control Facility
