 - Total waste shipments for March – 2 shipments totaling 31 cubic meters.
 - DMSA 11 & 12 made first shipment on March 17, 2009 to Nevada test site.

<i>Snyder:</i> What happens to Poly Bottles?	<i>Vost:</i> Pulling material out, down blending and creating a sellable product. The bottles themselves are ringed and stored are now non-contaminated.
<i>Smith:</i> What's sellable product?	<i>Vost:</i> Uranium for Nuclear fuel.
<i>Snyder:</i> Will excess materials disposition go to Utah?	<i>Franz:</i> They go to landfills, Utah, or recycled depending on criteria.
<i>Parker:</i> What's the criterion between Utah and Nevada?	<i>Franz:</i> Contaminated debris will go to Utah and nonhazardous to local landfill.

Snyder: What's the timeline for lube oil disposition?	Vost: Loading series of takers, bulk completed by end of 2009. Not all will be dispositioned from site since there is a use for some
Snyder: Is the lube oil removed from the switchyards?	Vost: No lube oil; but they are investigation ways to remove the pyranol.
Snyder: Will the D & D of that site affect pyranol disposition?	Vost: No, working with USEC to prep buildings to expedite D & D process.
