**1. Traveling Displays-**Jeff Wagner, FBP

<b>Question/Comment:</b>	<b>Answer:</b>
<p><b>Wagner:</b> I am passing out a draft schedule for the traveling displays. We will have four displays of which three will rotate to various locations for a three-four week period. The fourth display will be used for various one-five day functions (county fairs etc.) The one display that we have is a pull-up. We are thinking we might want something sturdier to leave for an extended time. I have looked around and found a couple of options. A vegemite display or a picture cube display.</p>	

<p>You think two cubes and one vegemite display.</p>	<p><b>Bandy:</b> Yes, that way there is a variety of shapes and sizes, some places may not have as much room as others.</p>
<p><b>Huber:</b> How sturdy are the cube displays? Do they need weighted down?</p>	<p><b>Wagner:</b> They said you do not need to weight them down. However, we can put a sand bag in the bottom to help make it sturdier.</p>
<p><b>Manson:</b> You could setup at the Dogwood Festival in May and Bristol Village in September for festivals.</p>


