Question/Comment:	Answer:
Snyder: Is nickel included in the 16 projects for FY-14?	Mingus: No, nickel is currently being evaluated, therefore the nickel is not on the asset recovery list.
Simonton: The asset recovery money that SODI gave to the four counties is local money for the counties, therefore the counties can apply for grants that otherwise they would not be able to apply for because a percentage of local funds is required. Those grants then allow for local projects to move forward.

Snyder: Our work plan for next month, I think it is about the RI/FS. Can we get a briefing at our February subcommittee meeting?	Galanti: I would suggest you go back and look at the nature of the comments. If you have any questions, give me a call. Yes, Melody can give an update next month.
Halstead: What about the freezing trouble you had with the steam plant that was caused by the cold weather? Did you get that all taken care of? Do you have a permanent fix?	Carr: We knew the storm was coming. Therefore, we tried to take precautions to prepare, using blankets and heat tape, but we still had problems. One of the tanks went down in the middle of the night, which took down the steam to the plant. The cleanup took about four days. We are working on building an enclosure for the boilers, and in the meantime, we have engineers looking to see what we could do to prevent problems if it gets that cold again.


DOE Asset Transition Agreement

- Through the DOE/SODI Asset Transition Agreement for Economic Development, SODI has issued grants to the four surrounding counties for development purposes and facility / infrastructure upgrades:
 - \$150,000 to a Scioto County industrial park upgrade project

 - \$150,000 to Pike County for a \$2.7M sewer expansion project
 - \$150,000 to Jackson County for an airport upgrade project
 - \$150,000 to Ross County for an industrial park upgrade project
