
➤ Mark Whitney Memorandum

- In earlier meeting today, EM-1 guidance regarding budget issues was discussed.
- DOE wants to hear input from stakeholders on their project priorities for FY17 and beyond.
- As part of EM-1 guidance, DOE will submit stakeholder input as supplement to site's FY17 budget submittal to DOE-HQ.



Integration

➤ Communication is key for alignment between the D&D Project and the community's future use goals.





Integration

- DOE has already worked to include community's end state goals into D&D Project planning.
- Examples include:
 - Consolidation of landfills into potential On-Site Waste Disposal Facility (OSWDF)
 - Consolidation of plumes into potential OSWDF
 - Inclusion of nickel segmentation shop
 - No plan for off-site waste materials into OSWDF
 - No plan for DUF₆ waste into OSWDF
 - Community Commitment Plan
 - Historic preservation activities
 - Public/educational outreach activities



Moving Forward

- DOE's Office of Environmental Management's mission is the D&D of the Portsmouth facility.
- Community's mission is an industrial complex that has the potential for future employment.
- Community may desire some site resources as useful for future success.
- Community's future use goals could impact end state configuration.
- As D&D Project progresses, DOE will continue to consider community's future use goals to find areas of commonality.



Community Collaboration

- SSAB, SODI, elected officials and other stakeholders agreed in 2012 on Future Use Vision.
- That vision called for an industrial park, but specific characteristics of the industrial park have yet to be determined.
- Assisting the community is easier for DOE if there is alignment within community groups on future use goals.
- SSAB can provide recommendations to DOE regarding Future Use as more information becomes available.
