

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## Piketon Police make drug arrest

**STAFF REPORT**

A traffic stop by the Pike County Police Department on Wednesday resulted in the arrest of a Waverly man on drug-related charges.

According to the Pike County Police Department, Patrolman Ratliff conducted a uniform traffic stop on Shyville Road of a vehicle driven by Michael Underwood, 30, of Waverly. During the course of the traffic stop, Ratliff reportedly found probable cause to search the vehicle and, during the search, located a substance believed to be methamphetamine as well as vials and other drug paraphernalia.

Underwood was arrested for aggravated possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug abuse instrument, and possession of drug paraphernalia. According to the police, from that traffic stop, it was also discovered that an active meth lab was in the works on Straight Creek Road. With combined efforts from the Pike County Sheriff's Office, items commonly used in the manufacture of methamphetamine were reportedly located.

Underwood was transported to the Scioto County Jail, and more charges are expected.



JEDISO is a regional cooperative between Jackson, Pike, Ross, and Scioto Counties to market and promote economic development in south central Ohio. The group is endorsed by Fluor-B&W Portsmouth and lays claim to having generated nearly \$90 million in investment in the four-county region since 2013.

Bennett Syverson, vice president and creative director for Ady Advantage, designed the website, drafted the regional target industry analysis and has worked with the counties over the last year.

"Ady Advantage works with dozens of economic development organizations throughout the year. One of the organizations that stands out is the team from JEDISO," Syverson said. "These four counties came together with a common goal and shared vision. They were brave enough to be decisive and made informed decisions that quickly moved them forward. JEDISO wasted no time and rocketed from regional research and planning to action with a branding program and the implementation of an aggressive marketing plan. The results have been impressive and we fully expect JEDISO to keep building on the momentum they have started."

The website, which has drawn interest from China, Brazil and France, was recently translated in Mandarin (China) and Portuguese (Brazil) to accommodate additional interest. The page has nearly 1,000 visits a month in trying to drive development to the region.
